

MEASURES ADOPTED BY CAMPING ESTANYET FOR THE PREVENTION OF COVID-19

The present situation, caused by COVID-19, forces us to establish a contingency plan for the reduction of hygienic/sanitary risks due to this threat. In order to ensure that your stay in our installations is safe and that it does not increase the risk of community contagion, it will be a mandatory requirement prior to your arrival, and in order to formalize the reservation, the acceptance of the adopted regulations and directives. We ask you to read this document carefully, which summarizes all the regulations and directives applied to the camping in order minimize COVID-19 risks, notwithstanding the current legislation, which needs to be complied with during your stay in Camping Estanyet. By entering our installations guests expressly accept their compliance.

1.- As a general norm during the entire stay it needs to be kept in mind the requirement to respect the safe distance ruled by the Ministry of Health to be 1.5 meters (5 feet). When this is not possible, the use of a mask will be mandatory.

2.- At the access point of any of the common areas, dispensers of hydroalcoholic gel (Hand Sanitizer) will be available. Maintain good hand hygiene in order to avoid virus propagation.

3.- Everybody must respect and comply with the indications displayed in signs and posters and distributed throughout the installations and to follow the displayed indications as well as those by our personnel.

4.- The use of a mask will be mandatory during the access to the following common areas and installations:

- Reception
- Sanitary facilities
- Supermarket
- Animation (Entertainment functions: during some activities where keeping the safe distance between people can not be ensured).

5. Always respect the obligations about capacity indicated in signage in sanitary facilities and swimming pool.

6. The use of sanitary facilities is exclusive for guests who do not have these services in their camping units.

7. Visits to the camping by family members and friends are restricted.

8. If during your stay at the camping you develop any of the following symptoms, please quickly contact reception or the night watchman: fever, cough, difficulty breathing, general tiredness, pain, nasal drip, sore throat, headache, diarrhea, and loss of smell and/or loss of taste.
